Location:

Field sessions take place on Donner Pass and the Sierra Crest, in Truckee, California. Alpenglow operates in partnership with the Truckee Donner Land Trust and the Tahoe National Forest

What to bring:

- Touring skis or snowboard with skins, boots, poles
- Avalanche transceiver, probe and shovel
- Backpack, 20-35 liters
- Food, water, sunscreen, lip balm
- Clothing
 - Under layers:
 - lightweight merino wool or synthetic long john top and bottom
 - lightweight merino wool or synthetic t-shirt
 - lightweight merino wool or synthetic briefs/ underwear
 - wool/ synthetic socks
 - Outer layers/ insulation:
 - Soft shell "guide pants", or hard shell goretex pants, conditions dependent
 - Soft shell jacket
 - Hooded puffy jacket (down or synthetic)
 - Hard shell jacket (waterproof/ breathable)
 - warm beanie
 - lightweight gloves with good dexterity
 - warm, waterproof gloves or mittens
- Misc:
 - sunglasses
 - goggles
 - camera
